Alexander noted that with the vacancies caused by relocating 17,000 military personnel working in Crystal City, the vacancy rate increased to 20 percent by 2017. He said that Amazon will be gradually phasing up its employment over twelve years. Accordingly, the full



complement of 25,000 new employees will not be finished until around 2030. He added that Arlington won Amazon's national competition for its new site against 238 competitors in 2017.

10/16: Our speaker was Scott Pedowitz, the Government Affairs Manager at the Arlington Chamber of Commerce. Scott spoke about the Chamber's work to



ensure a strong business environment in Arlington. He gave examples of how the Chamber engages on state and local issues, supports its members in their dealings with the government and rallies community support for good policy outcomes. (Photo by Shandra Niswander).
