LOT MANAGER and LOT CAPTAINS
ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

#### **VOLUNTEER TASKS**

IMPORTANT NOTE: On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, volunteers cannot park in the parking lot. Please find parking on neighborhood street. The parking lot is for customers only!

Follow CDC Guidelines at all times: 6' FEET APART and MASKS MANDATORY for all volunteers.

MAX LOT CAPACITY: 25

#### **Coaches & Parents**

- 1) An Optimist is the cashier (Only)
- Operating the chain saws safely
   Note chainsaw operations: (Safety is paramount)
  - Wear goggles if needed
  - Keep hands away from saw; grip safety shield on saw
  - Ensure saw has oil throughout the shift
  - Ensure there is NO string near saw blade; the string will gum up the saw causing it to not work
  - Clear customers and volunteers from saw area at all times particularly when operating saw
  - Use gloves
- 3) Organize youth and other volunteers on lot
  - Helping Customers with trees
  - Tying trees to the top of cars
  - Cutting twine and making rolls to be used to tie trees on cars
  - Sweeping lot
  - Replenishing trees at the end of every shift
- 4) Tree lot merchandise available:
  - Fraser Fir Trees and White Pine
  - Wreaths
  - Garland
  - White House tree Omaments
  - Medium size tree stands
- For any emergency or if you have questions: Contact lot captain for the week as noted on the Optimist lot schedule calendar. Captain information is at the top.

#### **Youth Volunteers**

- Review lot set up (Trees are organized by size)
- 2) Assist Customers in finding a tree:
  - Determine size
  - Pull tree out and twirl around
  - When customer selects a tree, carry to front of "shell" for fresh cut
  - Tie trees on top of cars
- 3) Sweep Lot/Keep tidy
- Make twine rolls to be used to tie trees on top of cars
- Replenish trees
- 6) Be courteous and optimistic at all times
