

Appendix: Optimist Youth Golf Program

Dear Optimist members.

Many Clubs have had to curtail many of their programs and projects during this past year due to the Covid 19 Pandemic, but we still have one District Project we all can and need to support. Our 2021 District Jr. World Golf tournament is scheduled for May 1st and May 2nd at the Hanover Golf and Country Club in Ashland, Virginia. Boys and Girls ages 10 yrs. – 18 yrs. will have the opportunity to compete for the honor of being one of the top Two Finishers of seven age brackets. The top Two Finishers of each bracket will then have the honor and opportunity to travel and compete in the International OPTIMIST Tournament scheduled for July at the Doral Resort and Spa in Miami, FL. Capital-Virginia District will cover the cost of the registration fee for each contestant which includes room and board while participating in this year's tournament.

PLEASE NOTE this District Project is different from our other scholarship programs in that ZERO dollars are included in the District budget to support this program. All financial support must be raised thru donations from Optimist Clubs, individuals and outside businesses. Clubs/ individuals can support this program in several ways:
